The following document, TOMBSTONE INSCRIPTIONS OF PERU, MASSACHUSETTS was initially prepared during the autumn of 1948 by Mrs. Max Lederer of Southampton, Mass. and Mrs. Homer Granger of Chesterfield, Mass. and includes every tombstone in Peru, to that date. A spiral-bound paper copy of this document is included in the Peru Library's Historical Commission files. To make this information more accessible, the original document was scanned as a .pdf and opened in MSWord to create an editable version. Once edits were performed and proofreading accomplished, the resulting document was again converted back to a .pdf for posting on the Town of Peru website. The original document remains in the Peru Library's collection. Please be aware that the original document served as the source for this update and no tombstones were checked to confirm information.

Corrections, clarifications and stories relating to family members long gone, are welcome by the Historical Commission.

A goal of the Cemetery Commission is to identify those who served our nation in uniform and are interred in our cemeteries. Some are clearly identified by their tombstone inscription, others are not. Any help from families, friends and town members would be greatly appreciated and will allow these graves to be appropriately recognized on Memorial Day.

It is my hope that this version will be used as the start for an update to include burials since 1948.

Many thanks to Mrs. Lederer and Mrs. Granger for their efforts and scholarship. This was no easy task!

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CENTER CEMETERY (1)

This cemetery is located on a side road just west of the center of Peru, and it is on a hillside plainly visible from the center, which consists of a church and a town hall and a few houses, also a schoolhouse. It is not in a good state of repair. Many of the stones are flat on the ground, and no mowing has been done. We tried to divide it into sections, but it was almost impossible. At some time there evidently had been driveways, and the first section is west of the drive way, starting at the west side of the cemetery and copied by rows parallel with the front fence from front to back, as much as possible.


This cemetery is on the road from Peru to East Windsor, about a half mile from the old stone school house, built in 1841, and about three miles from Peru Meetinghouse.


