Any Other Business: A suggestion for further consideration around the celebration of the Town's 250th anniversary is to develop a tour of historical town locations which could be mapped on paper and marker by new signs. The locations could include cellar holes, home of famous residents and the town cemeteries, etc. A funding request could be considered as part of the 2019 Annual Town Meeting.
