

## PERU BOARD OF HEALTH MEETING MINUTES

Monday June 14, 2021 10:00 AM


Community Room 3 E Main Rd


1. The meeting was called to order at 10:07 AM
2. Roll call: present Nanette Mone, Peggy White, Ed Fahey, Darryl Darby arrived late.
3. State Recording status Peggy White.
4. The minutes from the previous BOH meeting 5/13/21 were reviewed and a motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes, all in favor.
5. Ed Fahey's report: 1 East Main Rd conditional pass needs new D Box and tank. Plan to move the tank >100 feet from the well, 13 Stephanie Lane Title V conditional pass needs a new D Box, risers and outlet tree, 46 E Windsor Rd Conditional Pass needs a new D Box and lines cleaned, Camp DanBee inspected, schedule and fee paid, the board recommends waiting to issue the permit until the COVID isolation trailer has arrived, 4 David Drive Title V failed, Berkshire Septic to do installation, DSCP issued 9/20.
6. Update on hogweed, Jennifer Forman-Orth sent email with digital maps, stated no hogweed on 52 E Windsor Rd, she is sending certified letters to the affected property owners. Darryl will call the Blakes to let them know a letter will be arriving about the hogweed removal program. There are now new owners at 55 E Windsor listed as 55 E Windsor Rd LLC. The Board will drive to the hogweed site after the meeting for review purposes only.
7. Fish Consumption Advisory from Caroline Stone DPH, mercury has been found in 2 fish species chain pickerel and Large Mouth Bass in Lake Ashmere. Ed will forward the DPH email to Camp DanBee for their information.
8. The BHS CHP mobile Health Unit will be visiting Peru on 6/23/21 at 2:00PM both the J&J and Moderna COVID vaccines will be available. Signage is up and information will be posted on the town website, and Face Book pages as well. The Mobile Blood Bank is doing a Town Hall tour and plans to be in Peru this summer. It was suggested that they consider 7/17 as that is the day of the town tag sale.
9. COVID Update After discussion it was decided the BOH will suggest an advisory that unvaccinated people entering town Hall wear a mask. A box of PPE was received. The disposal surgical masks for adults and children went to the library as a mask enforcement is still in place. Nanette will reach out to the Police and Fire Departments about the other items: gowns, goggles, a box of glove and a few N95 masks. Any items not needed at this time and the signs will be saved. Vaccination sites were reviewed. The BOH also recommends the same mask advisory for upcoming events to be held in the Community Room that masks are worn if unvaccinated and to promote good ventilation as much as possible.
10. Reorganization of the Board. Peggy White was recently reelected. The current positions are chair held by Nanette, Peggy has been typing the minutes, serving as the representative to the BPHA Governor's Board and submitting the monthly Live Wire Update, Darryl is special projects including water testing. Motion, seconded and all in


- favor to nominate Peggy as the Chair. Peggy abstained from the vote. Nanette suggests that in the future the chair is held by the person in the last year of their term. Nanette will take on the role of typing the minutes. Water testing is due and Darryl will follow up.
11. The next meeting will be July 12, 2021 at 10:00 am. Items for the agenda include: Clarify alternate for Gov Bd, Nanette to discuss with Caleb is he wants to continue, Update on Hogweed, Ed Fahey's report, water testing, kitchen inspection as the Community Room will be used for several upcoming events, update on Mobile Health Unit.
  12. Motion made, seconded and all in favor to adjourn the meeting at 11:37AM.
