
### A note from the COA Board:

# **Medicare Savings Program Expansion 2023**

Did you know that the **Medicare Savings Plans** can help you pay for Medicare premiums and make you eligible for savings on your prescriptions? In January 2023, Massachusetts expanded the income and asset limits for the Medicare Savings Program, **so more people are now eligible for this program.** 

## Check these current 2023 numbers below to see if you may qualify!

Medicare Savings Plans	Gross Monthly Income Limit*	Asset Limit*	Benefits
MassHealth Senior Buy-In (QMG)	\$2,309 (Individual) \$3,123 (couple)	\$18,180 (Individual) \$27,260 (couple)	Medicare A, B premiums, deductibles and copays, automatic full extra help with prescription costs
MassHealth Buy- In SLMB, QI-1)	\$2,734 (Individual) \$3,698 (couple)	\$18,180 (individual) \$27,260 (couple)	Pays Medicare B premium and automatic full extra help with prescription costs
